#### Clean vs Flush

Cleaning a cache type deletes all items from enabled Magento cache types only.

In other words, this option does not affect other processes or applications because it cleans only the cache that Magento uses.

Disabled cache types are not cleaned.

Flushing a cache type purges the cache storage, which might affect other processes applications that are using the same storage.

Flush cache types if you've already tried cleaning the cache and you're still having issues that you cannot isolate.

#### **Default mode**

Enables you to deploy the Magento application on a single server without changing any settings. However, default mode is not optimized for production.

- Symlinks to static view files are published to the pub/static directory
- Exceptions are not displayed to the user; instead, exceptions are written to log files.
- Hides custom X-Magento-\*HTTP request and response headers



#### Developer mode

Intended for development only, this mode:

- Symlinks to static view files are published to the pub/static directory
- Provides verbose logging
- Enables <u>automatic code compilation</u>
- Enables enhanced debugging
- Shows custom X-Magento-\*HTTP request and response headers
- Results in the slowest performance (because of the preceding)



#### **Production mode**

Intended for deployment on a production system.

- Exceptions are not displayed to the user, exceptions are written to logs only
- Static view files are served from `pub/static` only.
- Static view files are served from `pub/static` only.
- New or updated files are not written to the file system.

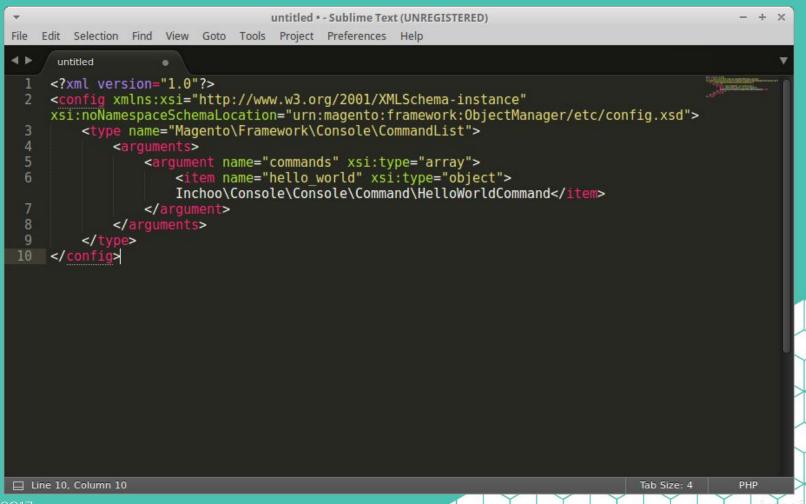

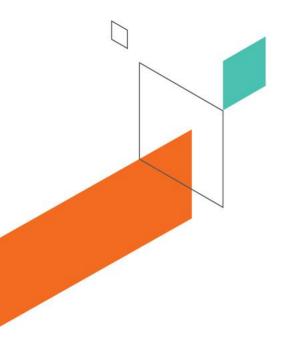
